These programs are offered to anyone who is expecting to become a parent, is currently pregnant, or who has a child between the ages of birth to eighteen.

The following group sessions are offered:

PRENATAL PREPARATION

An eight-week course which is focused toward future parents.



Topics include, but are not limited to:

- Deciding to become parents
- 1st—3rd trimester development
- Labor and delivery
- Time and stress management
- Child-proofing your home
- Breast-feeding versus bottle feeding.



PARENT EDUCATION

An eight-week class for parents using the STEP (Systematic Training for Effective Parenting) program.

Topics include, but are not limited to:

- Development
- Child care decisions
- Time and stress management
- Child-proofing your house
- Parenting styles
- Birth order
- Understanding behavior
- Communication
- Rules and discipline
- Building self-esteem

LOVE AND LOGIC

An eight-week class that goes beyond the basics of the Parent Education classes and looks at topics in a more in-depth fashion. Some of the topics include:

- Giving choices
- Setting limits
- Consequences versus punishment



ACTIVITY DAYS

Monthly theme-focused activity groups are designed to work on positive parent/child interaction and give parents the opportunity to meet other parents with young children. Some activities include:

- Songs
- Story time
- Simple crafts
- Other age-appropriate activities
