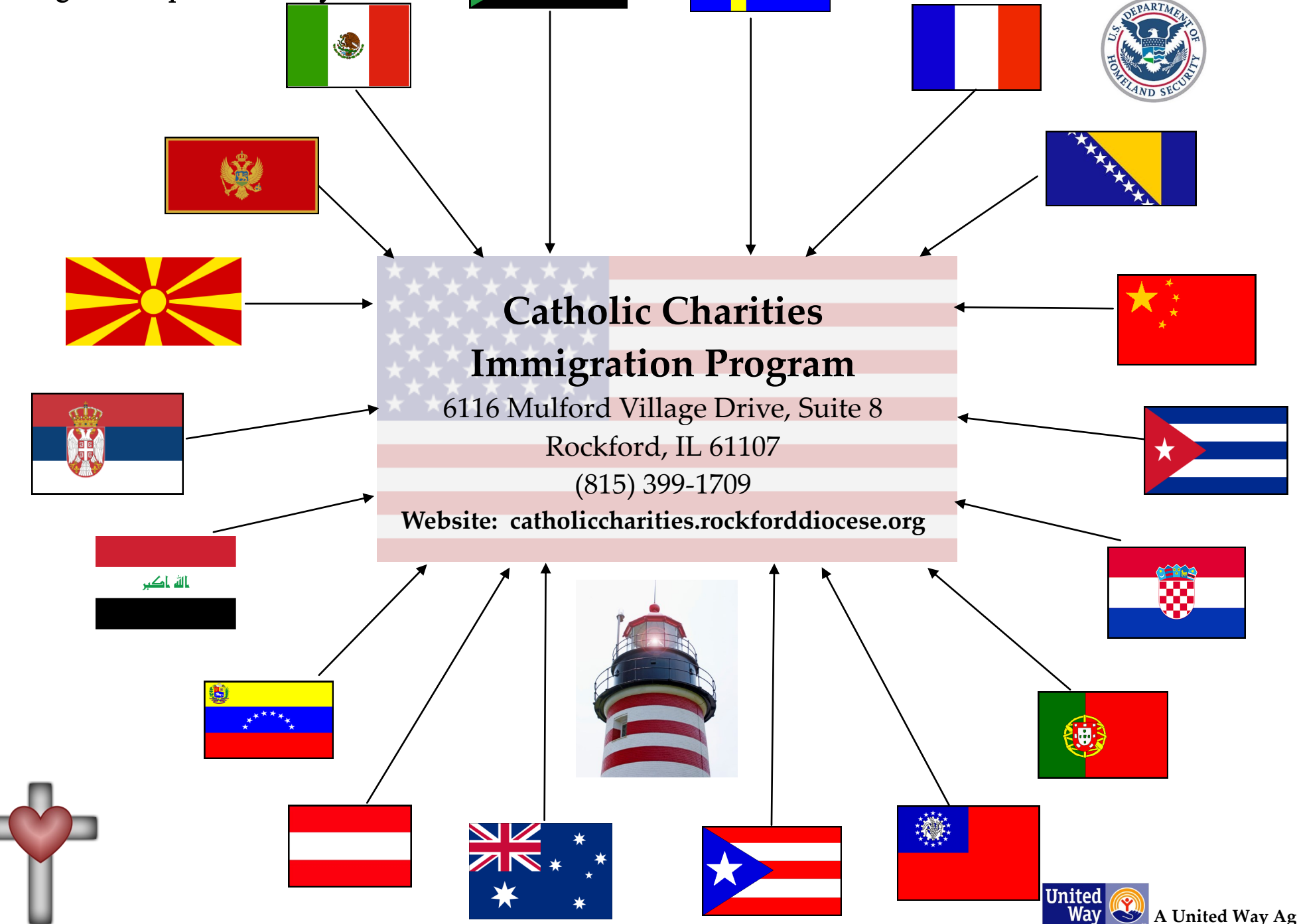

MISSION STATEMENT

To enhance and expand delivery of legal services to indigent and low-income immigrants principally through diocesan immigration programs and to meet the immigration needs identified by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB).

Immigration Services provides assistance to legal indigent and low income immigrants who need immigration counseling and help with the preparation of petitions and applications for citizenship. Catholic Charities is recognized - and several staff are Accredited - by the Board of Immigration Appeals in Washington, D.C.

We are affiliated with the Catholic Legal Immigration Network (Clinic), an organization established by USCCB/Migration and Refugee Services (MRS).

Catholic Charities' Immigration is approved as a Community-Based Organization by Homeland Security.

We provide:

- Immigration services focusing on the law's impact on families.
- Counseling and preparation of applications and petitions for submission to the Citizenship and Immigration Service.

Services include:

- adjustment of status
- immigrant and non-immigrant visas
- travel documents
- "green card" renewals
- other family-based petitions.
